





Welcome to Master National 2023!





Training/Test Site Rules & Regulations

The following "Guidelines" list important considerations for the use of the pre-Master National Training Grounds and the Master National Hunt Test Grounds. All these grounds were made available for this event by their property owners for the betterment of the community and their love of dogs. These rules and regulations are certainly not all inclusive of every possible situation that may arise. Please use common sense and above all professional courtesy while on the properties and when meeting others on the properties. We are GUESTS and we must utilize the properties with the least amount of intrusiveness as possible. The Training properties will be open from 8am-5pm on October 19th - October 25th. All properties will be available via the land draw. Drawing instructions are listed on the next page.

- 1. SMOKING OUTSIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED on the Test Grounds and all Training Property Grounds. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 2. No one may contact owners for individual or group use or access these properties except through the Hunt Test Committee.
- 3. The regulations listed for each property in the training catalog are in addition to these general guidelines.
- 4. Keep vehicles on the edges of fields and away from pond banks. Access fields only with UTV's or 4-wheelers if available.
- 5. Be wary of livestock and neighbors.
- 6. Never shoot in the direction of any visible residence.
- 7. Remove all your trash, including spent shells, dead birds and any other trash you find. Do not leave food scraps or spilled dog food on the grounds. Some properties specifically prohibit feeding on the grounds due to moving wildlife.
- 8. Stay well away from kennels and residences unless otherwise directed by property owners.
- 9. Dead birds must be disposed of at the Bird Disposal site.
- 10. Fire ants are endemic in the South. Their bites are a painful nuisance at best and can be serious for folks with allergies. Be wary of where you walk and place birds. Birds left on the ground for even a short time can draw those hungry critters. Use plastic bags or buckets and make sure hanging birds are far enough off the ground.

- 11. Unless instructed otherwise, please close and always secure all gates.
- 12. By entering any of these properties you acknowledge the risks inherent in outdoor sports whether such risks are apparent or hidden. All participants accept those risks and agree that they alone are responsible for the health and safety for themselves and others in their group. Participants, by their use of the property, acknowledge that they hold the property owners, MNRC, THRC, WGHR of Georgia, its officers and members harmless and free of any liability for any accidents, injuries or damage to their persons or vehicles. Entering any of the properties is further subject to the participants' agreement to be held fully responsible for any damage, accidental or otherwise, to the property and any animals, facilities, buildings or equipment located on the property.
- 13. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!! Especially on groomed grounds! USE Porta Potty on property if available for yourself!
- 14. If you are on any test or training property with residences do not air or feed dogs after the test or day ends. The grounds will be off limits once the workers depart.
- 15. Airing grounds open for use are Deep South Fair Grounds and pasture on Patterson Still Road.16. DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOGS TO SWIM IN PONDS OR LAKES HERE THAT ARE NOT APPROVED.MANY BODIES OF WATER HAVE ALLIGATORS!!!!


